<input type="checkbox"/>	Performance Length	The performance will begin <u>promptly at 11 a.m.</u> and will end at approximately 1:10 p.m. There is one intermission and one pause.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Leaving Before the Performance is Over	We hope and expect that you will stay for the entire performance. If your group needs to leave early for any reason, please let us know as soon as possible at <a href="mailto:lauel@pittsburghballet.org">lauel@pittsburghballet.org</a> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lunch Arrangements	Food and beverages are <u>not</u> allowed in the Benedum Center auditorium. Concession stands will not be open, and students will not be allowed to leave the theater or eat lunches in the lobby during the intermission. We recommend that students eat a hearty breakfast before coming to the theater and have bag lunches available on the buses for eating immediately after the performance
<input type="checkbox"/>	Electronic Devices	Please inform your students that the use of electronic devices is not allowed in the theater. Patrons are not permitted to take photos or videos of the performance. We recommend that all devices—cell phones, tablets, etc.—be left at home.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Arrival Time in Cultural District	Please plan ample travel time to allow for parking the buses, walking to the theater, and finding your seats. Arrange your schedule so that you arrive in the Cultural District between 10 and 10:30 a.m. Motorcycle police officers will escort buses to parking spaces on Ft. Duquesne Blvd.; students and teachers will walk from parked buses to the theater. No buses will be allowed to disembark passengers in front of the theater (unless you need special accommodations: please let us know in advance if this is the case).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Security Features	The Benedum Center now requires all patrons to pass through metal detectors. This may mean a little bit of a wait outside the theater. Students should not bring backpacks or tablets. Students should not bring purses, if possible, as all purses will be checked. Bags /purses must not be larger than 16 x 16 x 8 - you will not be able to bring larger bags into the building. Place in the bus window before arriving in Pittsburgh so police know you're attending the PBT matinee.</li> <li>• Please make sure you have your bus driver's cell phone number for contacting him/her if the need arises.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Parking for Patrons driving cars to the performance	The <a href="#">Theater Square</a> garage is closest to the Benedum.
